Working as a veterinary professional is wonderful, but it doesn't come without its risks. Our domestic animals often find the environment strange, scary and stressful for many reasons and frequently react using many different behaviours. In this talk, I want to discuss the ways we can help to identify, manage and prevent the build-up of stress to keep them relaxed, and our accident book entries to a minimum!

- * understanding body language
- * trigger stacking
- * how to reduce stress in the surgery
- * effects of stress
- * how to overcome negative associations with the practice
