Entry Requirements

Aims of the Animal Nursing Assistants Course

The course is designed for students interested in developing a career in Animal Care or Veterinary Nursing, based within a veterinary practice.

Following completion of the course, if a satisfactory standard is achieved, students may use this as a science qualification to progress on to the RCVS veterinary nursing program leading to the RCVS Veterinary Nursing Diploma Level 3 Qualification
