Entry Requirements

There are no qualification requirements needed to enrol on the ABC Animal Nursing Assistants Course. Students attending on this course will be enrolled with Awarding Body Consortium (ABC) through LSVN and should be in full or part-time employment in a veterinary practice, prior to enrolment.

Aims of the Animal Nursing Assistants Course

The course is designed for students interested in developing a career in Animal Care or Veterinary Nursing, based within a veterinary practice.

Following completion of the course, if a satisfactory standard is achieved, students may use this as a science qualification to progress on to the RCVS veterinary nursing program leading to the RCVS Veterinary Nursing Diploma Level 3 Qualification which can be offered through LSVN
